Still be my vision O ruler of all

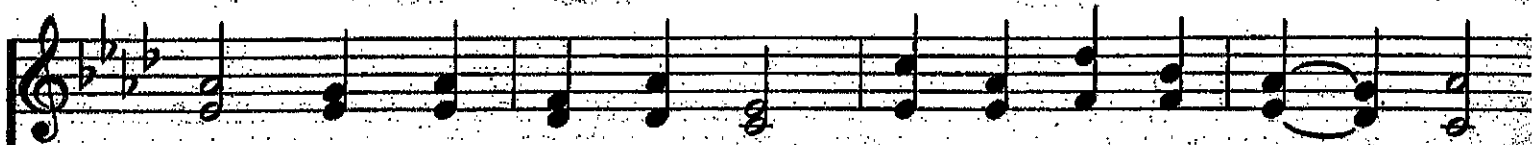




