2024 KMPC Capital Fund Campaign

In the first quarter of this year, the church incurred two extraordinary expenses that depleted our Capital Fund by over \$26,000:

- *January: One of the two boilers of the church needed to be replaced at a cost of \$13,600.
- *March: It was discovered that there had been a water leak from the stained glass window above the front church doors which caused extensive water damage to the doors and damage to the interior wall of the vestibule. Repairs of the doors, window and wall resulted in a \$12,500 expense.
